

Green & Nolin Rivers Blueway ACCESS POINTS:

Mammoth Cave National Park (MACA) sees 10,000 to 15,000 paddlers annually. Most paddling use (85%) within MACA occurs through three authorized liveries. About 15% are private paddlers on the river in their own vessels.

We offer the following public access points:

- Dennison Ferry, amenities include:
 - River access: both for liveries and for the general public
 - Picnicking
 - Opportunities for: river watching, bird watching, and enjoying nature
 - Parking
 - Restrooms
 - Informational Signage for river users

- Green River Ferry, amenities include:
 - River access: both for liveries and for the general public
 - Picnicking
 - Fishing
 - Hiking the accessible Echo River Trail which connects to several other park trails
 - Four interpretive exhibits relating to the Green River as well as Mammoth Cave and Echo River Spring
 - Opportunities for: river watching, bird watching, and enjoying nature
 - Parking
 - Restrooms
 - Informational Signage for river users

- Houchin Ferry, amenities include:
 - River access: both for liveries and for the general public
 - 12 Camping Sites - 887 people camped at Houchin Ferry in 2019
 - Picnicking
 - Shelter for group functions
 - Fishing
 - Hiking alongside the river
 - Opportunities for: river watching, bird watching, and enjoying nature
 - Parking
 - Restrooms
 - Water Spigot
 - Informational Signage for river users

- Nolin River Lake Tailwater Recreation Area Facility, amenities include:
 - 1 Single Lane Boat Ramp
 - 2 Picnic Shelters
 - 1 Playground
 - 1 Restroom
 - 2 Vault Toilets
 - Two Bulletin Boards
 - 1 sign informing visitors of river conditions from the dam to the confluence of the Green River.

- Lock 6 Site, amenities include:
 - Single Lane Boat Ramp
 - Fishing
 - Park
 - Planned amenities: shelter, picnicking

- Brownsville Boat Ramp, amenities include:
 - 1 Single Lane Boat Ramp
 - Fishing
 - Picnic Area located in adjacent park
 - Restrooms
 - Parking

- Alexander Creek Ramp, amenities include:
 - 1 Single Lane Boat Ramp
 - Fishing
 - Parking
