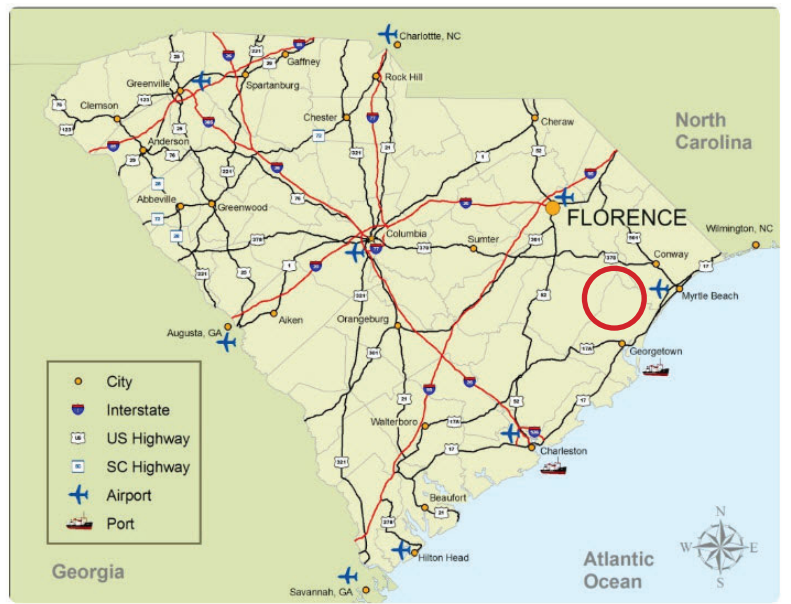
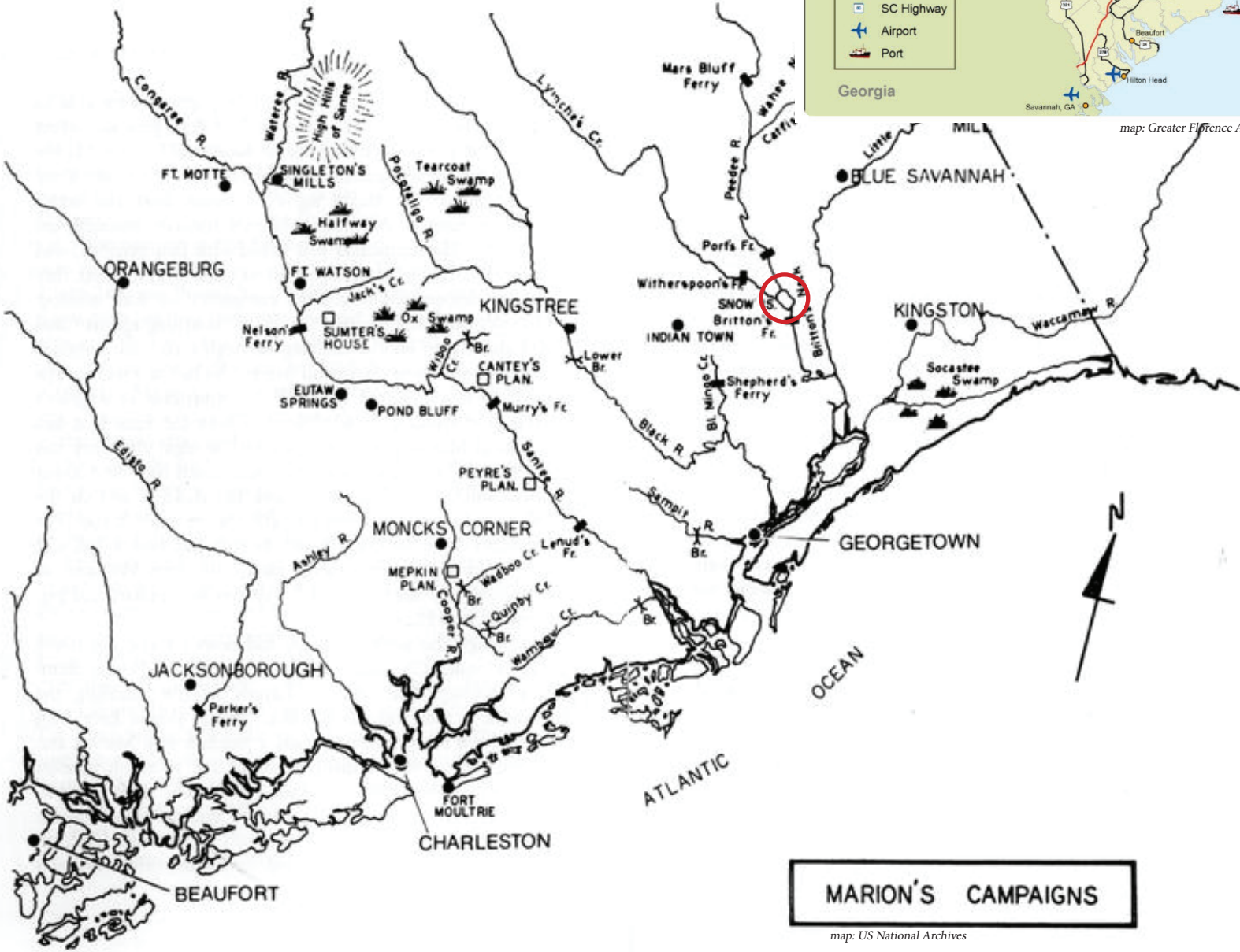


# Snow's Island

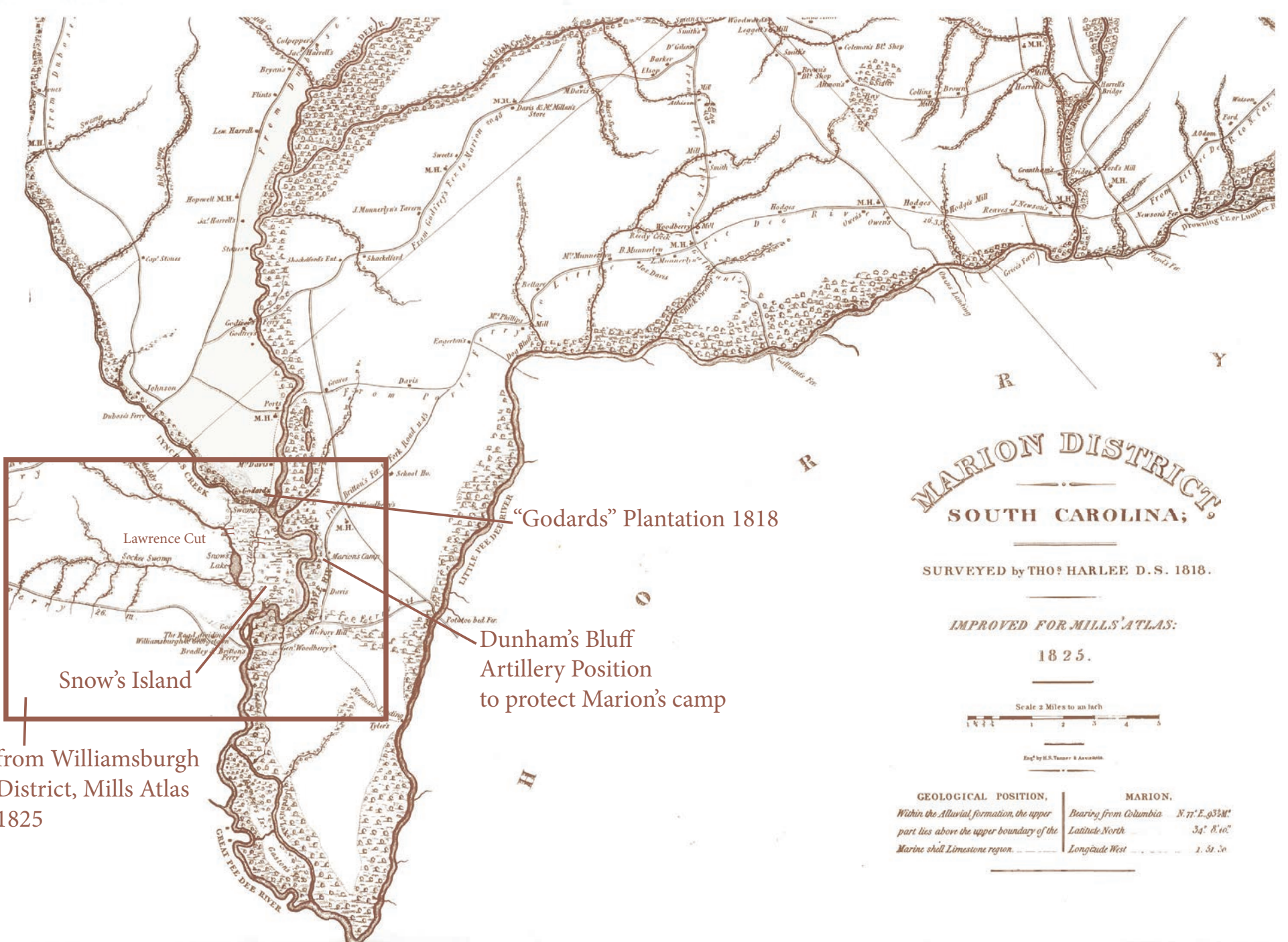
Located near Johnsonville, South Carolina, Snow's Island was the secret hideout of General Francis Marion (The Swamp Fox) in the Southern Campaign of the American Revolution, 1780-81. Marion and his men used guerrilla warfare to attack the British and then disappeared into the swamps. Snow's Island was the base camp for Marion's legendary "Bridges Campaign."
